Because of the regular shape of bamboo, can be arranged and combined into a variety of shapes, and easy to color, so now mostly used for architectural interior decoration screens and some decorative items, but also commonly used in the decoration of the building courtyard.

2.3. Color

The use of color in the process of modern architectural decoration design is often more bold and will not be bound, but for traditional decorative elements, the application of color is often more strict. In the design of the most commonly used colors are black, white, yellow and red, different colors represent different hierarchies, in the application process also needs to be combined with the idea, so that the specific meaning of color can be fully reflected.

This kind of script is used on the facade of the building, not only does it not lose the mood of traditional writing, but also has the beauty of modern art, which is a model of design.

3.2. Expression of Traditional Colors in Modern Architectural Decoration Design

Red is the representative color of China, and red has given the symbol of auspiciousness, joy and justice since ancient times. In ancient times, vermilion was the right color in China, and the palace walls and gates were decorated with vermilion. In modern architectural design, important buildings with symbolic meaning often express their mood through the red color of the national flag. The Chinese National Pavilion in Shanghai has a traditional crown shape with red color to give a sense of solemnity and majesty. The red color of the façade deepens from the bottom to the top, reflecting the classic visual effect of "Chinese red" under different lighting and perspectives.

The new process can optimize the performance of decorative materials, such as after processing, bamboo's fire resistance and poor corrosion resistance and other shortcomings to make up, so that bamboo can be widely used in large interior design. For stone, traditional architecture is mainly the use of stone load-bearing capacity, stone in addition to maintaining its hard, wear-resistant and good texture advantages, modern processing technology to make it more lightweight, high strength, beautiful and easy to build, mostly for the overall decoration of the facade.
